#### Required Qualifications:

- Attend middle school in West Virginia and plan to be in attendance next year
- A resident of West Virginia
- A **seventh grade** student at the time of application
- Must not have attended GSI in the past
- Have a grade-point average of at least 3.0
- Have a recommendation from the school principal (within this application)
- Have a recommendation from a math or science teacher (within the application)
- Have one other teacher recommendation (within the application)
- Must satisfy all immunization requirements set by the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources (DHHR). Nonpublic school and homeschool students must provide proof of immunizations.

#### General Information

- The state deadline for Part I and II of the application is **Friday**, **April 11**, **2025**. It is the responsibility of the student to collect all required documents.
- Part II of the application (this form and all supporting documents as required within the
  application) are submitted to the school counselor. The school counselor must scan the
  application and supporting documents into one PDF file and submit the electronic files to
  the principal for the school recommendation. Once the principal has signed the principal
  recommendation form, the school must submit the PDF applications and the
  recommendation for to the county superintendent.
- A copy of transcripts is required with the application. This document will need to be provided by the school counselor.
- Within the application, you will be required to secure two recommendations. Please provide sufficient notice to your teacher prior to submitting the application.
- On the final page of this application, you will find a checklist of all required pieces. We recommend asking a teacher or counselor to review all student information before submitting the completed application to the school counselor.
- Students may not apply to attend GSI at Green Bank during the 8<sup>th</sup> grade year if they are accepted to GSI WVU in 7<sup>th</sup> grade.
- IMPORTANT: WV Governor's Schools is a summer commitment for students. If you are selected to attend and you confirm your participation, we expect you to fully participate in the programs. If you decide to leave voluntarily during the school, you will not be permitted to apply for any other Governor's Schools in the future.

- Transcript Record for all of middle school and the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the current year.
- Immunization records for nonpublic school and homeschool students.

#### The school counselor will scan all documents into one file for each student application.

A selection committee at the school will determine students who are recommended from each school. Students who are selected will be recommended to the county superintendent for final selections.

The West Virginia Department of Education is not accepting paper submissions of applications. Once the counselor has scanned all required documents into one file for each student, those files will be submitted electronically from the school to the county and then uploaded to the state file submission from the county superintendent's recommendations. The county contact uploads the county selections to the file submission.
