Fund Code Additions

- 33 Kanawha County Public Library Fund*
- 53 Capital Projects Multi-County Vocational Center**

*The change replaced fund 33 Third Bond Issue with Kanawha County Public Library Fund. Kanawha County has used the fund for many years at the direction of OSF.

**The fund was added due to multiple districts having the need to account for MCVC capital facility projects.



Fund Code Additions

- 7X Federal Stimulus and Stabilization Fund
 - 71 Federal Stimulus and Stabilization Fund County Board of Education
 - 72 Federal Stimulus and Stabilization Fund Multi-County Vocational Center
 - 73 Federal Stimulus and Stabilization Fund Educational Services Cooperatives

**The funds were added to account for the financial resources of LEAs, MCVCs, and ESCs received through the federal government; most notably in regards to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act.



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Project Code Additions

- 04Y51 Jobs and Hope: Training Support
- 04Y52 Jobs and Hope: Education Assistance

**These are new grants that were awarded to only a few county boards of education and ESCs and replaced Jobs in Making You Succeed grants.



Project Code Additions

- 08Y7X Step 7d*
- 17Y3X Alternative Education Discretionary**
- 29Y4X Attendance Incentive Bonus***

*The project code was added to account for Step 7d funds that are now restricted by statute due to the passage of HB 4804.

**This is a new alternative education grant that was awarded to a few county boards of education during FY20.

***The project code was added to account for reimbursements to county boards of education for payments made to employees eligible for the attendance incentive bonus statutorily required by HB 206.



Project Code Additions

- 23Y Safe Schools Fund
 - 23Y1X Safe Schools Fund
 - 23Y2X School Access Safety

**The project codes were added/amended to include school access safety grant awards under a larger safe schools fund project grouping. The safe schools fund was created by SB 632 during the 2019 Legislative Session. The funding is to be used to install cameras in self-contained special education classrooms with any remaining funds to be used for "safety and security measures".



Project Code Additions

- 52Y Elementary and Secondary Schools Emergency Relief Fund (ESSERF)
 - 52Y1X Elementary and Secondary Schools Emergency Relief Fund (ESSERF)

**The project code was added to account for ESSERF funding allocations provided by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act.



Project Code Deletions

- 04Y3X Jobs in Making You Succeed: Operational Funds
- 04Y41 Jobs in Making You Succeed: AWS Welding Expansion
- 04Y42 Jobs in Making You Succeed: FANUC Manufacturing Robotic Arm Expansion
- 04Y43 Jobs in Making You Succeed: Heavy Equipment & Construction Expansion

**These grant awards were replaced by Jobs and Hope awards in FY20.



Project Code Deletions

**The project codes were removed due to the funds no longer being restricted after the passage of HB 206 during the 2019 special legislative session.



Revenue Source Code Additions

- 03916 Attendance Incentive Bonus Reimbursement*
- 05212 Interfund Transfer from Excess Levy Fund**

*The revenue source code was added to account for reimbursements to county boards of education for payments made to employees eligible for the attendance incentive bonus statutorily required by HB 206.

**The revenue source code was created for county boards of education to track fund transfers out of the excess levy fund into other funds.



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Program/Function Codes

The Office of School Finance has worked with the appropriate program offices within WVDE to determine the necessary changes to the lists of WVDE CTE and Adult Education approved Programs of Study listed under each 313XX and 616XX program/function code.
